German Ruhr U19 International 2022

10th to 14th October 2022

Dear friends,

German Badminton Association has the pleasure to invite your umpires to officiate at the German Ruhr U9 International 2022 as a part of the BEC Junior Circuit.

The invitation is based on the following terms:

- The organizer will provide transport to and from Dusseldorf International Airport (DUS) or Muelheim train station "Hauptbahnhof"
- The organizer will provide accommodation (including breakfast) in twin shared 'non-smoking' rooms in "**** Best Western" and / or the "**** Holliday Inn Express" in Muelheim
- The organizer will provide full meals in the hall or a subsistence daily allowance.
- All travelling expenses to / from Muelheim will be on account of the umpires or their national association.
- Umpires are requested to be present at the Umpires briefing on Sunday 09th October 2022 at 18:00h (tbc by referee).
- Departure should not be planed before 17:00h on the 14th of August, exceptions from this may be possible but should be checked before with the organizer

You will be notified soon after the selection.

COVID-19 situation:

As the tournament is taking place during the Covid-19 pandemic please be aware that the realisation of the event is subject to German Government and the regulations of the Northrhine-Westfalia Regional Government and the approval of the City of Muelheim, which may be taken back at any time.

Should the event be cancelled with short notice due to the Covid-19 situation – beyond the control of Badminton Europe (BEC), German Badminton Association (DBV) or the organizer GW Muelheim e.V. - neither of them will be liable for any costs related to travelling or accommodation made by the Technical Official for this event.

As of today, in accordance with the regulations of the Northrhine-Westfalia regulation “Corona Schutzverordnung” each participant must show a certificate of vaccination or a certificate of recovery from Covid-19 (not older than 6 month) or a daily negative rapid antigen test to enter the venue.
