The umpires are expected to arrive on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> of May, 2022 before the umpire briefing which will probably be at 20:00 in the venue.

Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup> 17:00 - 22:00 Quarter Finals


Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup> 09:00 - 13:00 Semi Finals

Umpires are expected to book flights to Luxembourg Findel (LUX) or by train to Luxembourg city Main station.

From the airport we will provide a free shuttle service. A tournament representative will be at the airport from 09:00 to 19:00 to guide you to our free transport who will take you to the venue.

From the main station you will take the tramway until the coque station. A representative of the tournament will take it with you. The Tramway is free.



During the all tournament there will be no transport. The hotel is in the venue itself.

- Any travel costs will be on account of the umpire or their own national organization. Transport from the airport or the main station to the venue is free of charge.

- Umpire uniform will be all black.
